## HCCA WILL HEAR FROM HILLCREST SCHOOL PRINCIPALS IN JUNE



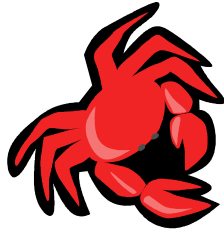
